What is it?

Google Forms is an online application where you can manage registrations, create opinion polls, surveys, and more. You can analyze the results as they pop up in real time and easily keep track of all information for later use.

How is it used in class?

- This can help start class discussions and keep track of how students are doing as a whole.

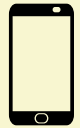

Students
