What is it?

Jamboard is a free collaboration space in which students and instructors can add to and create multiple interactive whiteboard spaces. Once you have filled up one board, simply click the next arrow at the top to add more slides and expand your board.

Jamboard is great for visual assignments, as a tool to aid in discussion, or small group work, like brainstorming or storyboarding for a video project.
