What is it?

Nearpod is an app and online learning tool where instructors can create interactive presentations including quizzes, polls, video responses, and more.

How is it used in class?

- Instructors can create Nearpod lessons that can be completed in or outside of class with a five letter code.
- Instructors can monitor the polls and quiz responses within the Nearpods and choose which subject to review.

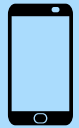

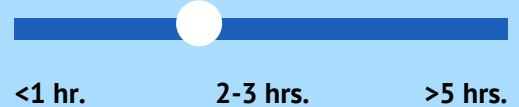

- Students do not need accounts to access Nearpods.

Instructors

- Instructors can create their own Nearpods or use a pre-made lesson in the Nearpod library.
- Instructors can monitor student progress and receive feedback on student responses.
- Nearpod lessons can count as a graded assignment or an asynchronous learning option.
- If contacted, Nearpod provides a Higher Education version that gives instructors even more flexibility with Nearpod.
