What is it?

Slido is a free app and online presentation add-on with Q&A and polling options. Slido works to create interactions and involve employees in discussions during in-person or online meetings.

How is it used in class?

Instructors can integrate Slido with their class presentations to take and ask questions anonymously in class or remotely.

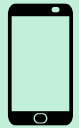

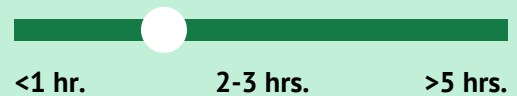
